

Omnipaque - 3 Dose Bowel Preparation

If your appointment is in the <u>MORNING</u>, follow the instructions below

The following instructions are for appointments between **8am and 12 noon only** – please check your appointment time.

How to take Omnipaque 300

- It is essential you take the three doses of the medication provided according
 to the following instructions (rather than the manufacturer's leaflet). The
 preparation of the medication and a suggested timetable for food and
 medication has been provided to maximise the success of the procedure and
 reduce the amount of side effects experienced.
- 2. Your Omnipaque is supplied in 3 X 50ml bottles.
- 3. To make one dose, mix one bottle of the Omnipaque with an equal amount (50mls) of water. Stir until solution is clear or slightly hazy.

KEEP HYDRATED- DRINK ONE CUP OF WATER (250ml) EVERY HOUR

Suggested routine to prepare for your procedure

The day before your	Eat breakfast as normal, avoiding high fibre foods, fruits
procedure	and vegetables. You may have milk and dairy products
	for breakfast. This will be the last solid meal until after
Breakfast 7-8am	your procedure
9am	From this time onwards, DO NOT EAT ANY SOLID
	FOOD , your bowel needs to be completely empty for your
	procedure. You can drink clear soups, soft drinks and
	black tea or coffee with sugar if you wish.
Lunch 12am	You can have clear soups such as Bovril or Oxo.
	Take one of the bottles of Omnipaque (50ml)
	Remember to drink an additional 500ml of water
	following this dose.
4pm	Take one of the bottles of Omnipaque (50ml)
	Remember to drink an additional 500ml of water
	following this dose.
8pm	Take another bottle (50ml) of Omnipaque at 8pm.
-	Remember to drink an additional 500ml of water in
	between these doses.
The day of your	DO NOT EAT ANYTHING . Remember to continue to
procedure	drink plenty of clear fluids (one cup every hour), until an
	hour before your appointment time.
	Leave home in time for your hospital appointment.

Possible Side Effects

Omnipaque may make you feel nauseated or be sick. The lack of solid food can trigger nausea. We suggest you drink plenty of clear fluid to help prevent this. We advise you to remain in easy reach of a toilet as this preparation may cause multiple, often urgent bowel movements. Occasionally an allergic reaction can occur, with or without a rash, if you experience this please seek medical advice.

Clear Soup, Bovril, Oxo

Fruit Juice without pulp

Soft Drinks, Diluted Cordials (except blackcurrant)

Herbal Tea, Black Tea no milk, Black Coffee no milk
